- 1) * Passengers for Hatchet Lane at 15.10 from Charters School use service 28.
- 2) The 24A Relief services from Brookside at 07.27 and the 24 Relief service at 15.10 from Sunningdale (Charters School) will only run if required.
- 3) Routes 24B, 24C, 24D and 24E in the morning do not call at all stops.
- 4) The 24L service at 16.30 from Sunningdale (Charters School) will call at Sunningdale Station, Broomhall Lane, The Rise and Sunninghill if required. Consequently, the times shown from The Berystede Crossroads onwards may be approximately 10 minutes later than shown. This journey will also divert from North Street Winkfield along Crouch Lane, Winkfield Lane and Drift Road if required.
- 5) Service 24D continues as Service 23 to Windsor and Old Windsor

Return and other concessionary fares are not available on this route except that Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Concessionary Pass holders may travel without charge on production of their pass. However, subject to space, multi-journey and student term tickets are available at discounted rates on application to the Company.

Multi-journey tickets are **advance payment** tickets valid for 10 single journeys. Journeys are cancelled by the driver. New tickets may be ordered from the driver (or the company) and collected from the driver the next time a journey is made. The driver does not carry ticket stocks so please make sure that a new ticket is ordered and paid for before the old one is used up.

Term tickets are available Monday to Friday for a single journey to and from school on schooldays only. They must be shown to the driver each time the bus is boarded and must be kept available for inspection throughout the journey. If the ticket is not produced, then the ordinary fare for the journey is payable. No refund of such fares will be made.

These tickets are for the use of the named holder only. If the ticket is transferred to any other person, then the ticket will be forfeited and both the person using it and the person transferring it may be liable to prosecution.

Lost term tickets will be replaced on payment of the replacement charge. This is currently **£15.00**

If you do not have a valid, paid-for multi-journey ticket or term ticket then the normal single fare is payable.
